And we do certify that being fully satisfied that the notices require by law have been given pursuant to statute, we on the 23rd day of March, 1847 it being the day specified in said notice at the hour and place appointed therein we examined the route of said proposed highway, heard all reasons offered for or against laying out the same were of the opinion that such highway was necessary and proper and to lay out the same and caused a description of said road to be made which description in the words and figures following.

Beginning at the Southwest corner of Section 16, Township 3 North Range 11 East and running thence South on the West line of Section 21, 28, and 33 to the Southwest corner of Section 33 all of the same township and range; thence South on the East side of Section 5 in Township 2 Range 11 East 30 chains and 84 links; thence North 80° West 12 chains and 50 links; thence South 63° West 68 chains; thence South 45° West 27 chains and 50 links to the line on the South side of said Section 5; thence West on the South line of said Section 5 3 chains and 75 links to the Southwest corner of said section; thence West on the South line of Section 6 to the Southwest corner of said Section 6 of Township 2 Range 11 East. Said road is four rods in width.
