We the Commissioners of Highways in and for the Town of Center, Rock County, Wisconsin Territory have this 23rd day of April A. D. 1847 laid out and established a public highway in said town. Beginning at the Southwest corner of Section 2, Township No. 2, Range 11 East; thence West between Sections 3 and 10, 4 and 9, five and eight, to the highway running West from near the Southwest corner of Section 5 all of Township 2 Range 11 East. Said road is four rods in width.

And now we the Commissioners aforesaid in and for said town do on the day and year first above written order and declare the road first above described to be a public highway and we do further order the same to be opened as such pursuant to statute.
