

Order for Laying of Highway

Whereas on the 11th day of June 1895 the undersigned supervisors of the town of Plymouth in the County of Rock, decided against the application to their duly made by G. D. Silvertorn and others, dated the 21st day of December A.D. 1894 to lay out a highway described in such application as follows: beginning at the termination of the highway running North and South on the section line between sections 8 and 9; thence running South on the Section line between sections 16 and 17 and 20 and 21 to intersect a highway running East and West on or near the quarter line of said sections 20 and 21 and afterwards upon appeal taken by G.D. Silverthorn from the determination so refusing to lay out such highway as aforesaid, commissioners were duly appointed to review the said determination, and such proceedings were duly had before them that the same was finally reversed as appears by their decision on said appeal duly filed in the office of the town clerk of Plymouth on the 3rd day of August 1895,

Now therefor in conformity with said decision and pursuant to the application before mentioned it is hereby ordered and mentioned and it is hereby ordered and determined that a highway be and the same is hereby laid out in said town as follows, to wit: Beginning at the termination of the highway running North and South on the Section line between Sections 8 and 9; thence running South on the Section line between Sections 16 and 17 and 20 and 21 to intersect a highway running East and West on or near the quarter line of said Sections 20 and 21 the same being an accurate survey of said highway caused by to be made, the line of said survey is the center of said highway and the same is laid out of the width of four rods.
