At a duly notified meeting of the Supervisors of the town of Porter held for the purpose of considering the utility of acting upon a petition asking for the laying of a public highway and being satisfied that such a highway would be for the public good and that all the preliminary steps have been taken as provided by law. We the said supervisors do hereby order and direct the following survey of a road to be made; beginning at the quarter post on the section line between section 1 and 2 T. 4 Range 11 East, thence running South on the Section line between sections 1 and 2, 11 & 12 to the quarter post intersecting the road running East and West through the middle of sections 11 & 12. We the said supervisors do hereby declare the above described road to be a public highway, four rods wide the line surveyed to be the center of said road.
