Recites in part---it is ordered and determined, and we do hereby order and determine that a highway be and the same is hereby laid out as follows to wit: Commencing at the center of Section 14 one and half rods North. Said point is the center of said highway and running East parallel with the South line of the N.E.¼ of said section to the school house site of District No. 3; thence North, along the West line of said site to the center of the highway known as the Middle Road running from Janesville to Beloit, being the dividing line between Sections 13 and 14. Said road to be of uniform width of 3 rods.

In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands this 23rd day of November, 1868.

Oct. 5th, 1892

Recites in part,---A highway upon the town line between the Towns of Rock and Plymouth--beginning at the Northeast corner of the Southeast quarter of Section 12 of the Town of Plymouth and the Northwest corner of the Southwest quarter of Section 6 of the Town of Rock; thence running South on the line between said towns of Rock and Plymouth to the Southeast corner of Section 13 of the Town of Plymouth and the Southwest corner of Section 18 of the Town of Rock to intersect a road running East from said end of proposed highway.

Notice is therefore hereby given that we the undersigned supervisors of said towns will meet on the 18th day of October 1892 at ten o'clock in the forenoon of that day at the house of Patrick Finley in the Town of Rock and decide upon such application. Dated this 5th day of Oct. 1892.
