We, the undersigned, supervisors of the town of Spring Valley, in the County of Rock, having by and order bearing date the second day of September, 1907, upon due application for that purpose, altered that certain highway in said town running easterly and westerly along the south line of sections 15 and 16 and the North line of sections 21 and 22 by discontinuing and vacating that portion of said highway the center line of which commences at a point on the section line between sections 15 and 16 and two rods north of the south west corner of section 15 and the south east corner of section 16 and running thence North on the section line to the Northernly line of the Right of Way of the Chicago Milwaukee & St. Paul Railway Co. and by laying out and opening a highway for the purpose of connecting the portions of said road separated by such discontinuance, the center line of which shall commence at a point in the section line between sections 16 and 21 and 2 rods west of the South East Corner of section 16 and the North East corner of section 21, and running thence westerly on the section line between said sections 16 and 21 to a point where said section line intersects the Northernly line of the right of way of the C. N. & St. Paul Railway Co., at which point it will connect with said highway so that said highway shall, when so altered be discontinuing, vacating, laying out and opening as aforesaid, be a continuous highway upon and along the section line between sections 16 & 21, and the following named owners of lands through which said highway is laid out and opened and abutting upon that part of said highway discontinued, not having released all claim to damages, sustained by reason of altering said highway by discontinuing and opening, and laying out the same as aforesaid, and the undersigned not being able to agree with them as to the amount of such damages, having applied to them for that purpose, and endeavoring to make such agreement we, the said supervisors, did at the time of making said order, assess the damages which such owners will generally sustain by reason of altering by discontinuing, laying out and opening said highway as above mentioned, and having taken into consideration the benefits which each owner aforesaid may receive thereby, we award such damages
