The three Supervisors of the Town of Tuttle met this day with the three Supervisors of the Town of LaPrairie to act in accordance with petitions for laying out a townline road between the above named towns. Owner, H. Stark, acted as Chairman and A.T. Bennett as Secretary for the Joint Board.

The notice from LaPrairie could not be obtained as the gentlemen who serve was home. Consequently, the board could take no definite action on the business which had called them together. But having examined the ground and determined the feasibility and necessity of a road. William H. Stark has appointed a committee to obtain releases from property holders along the route of the proposed road. After discussing other matters in connection with the subject the joint boards adjourned to meet at the public house in Shopier on Saturday, the 27th day of September next at one o'clock P.M.
