The Supervisors of Turtle and LaPrairie met pursuant to adjournment at the public house at one o'clock P.M., both boards being full to take further action on the town line road for which this meeting was appointed.

Not being able to make satisfactory arrangements with the land holders along the line of the proposed road, the board adjourned to meet at this place on Saturday the 18<sup>th</sup> day of October at one o'clock P.M.

The Joint Boards of the Supervisors for the Towns of Turtle and LaPrairie met at the house of William H. Starks pursuant to notice previously given to consider a petition for a town line road between the Towns aforesaid described as follows to wit:

Beginning at a point in the highway at or near the line between the Towns of Turtle and LaPrairie at the quarter line between Sections 3 and 34; thence East on or near said section line to section line between Sections 2 and 35; thence East on or near said section line to the Turtle Creek Road (so called); thence Eastwardly across the creek at such point as the said supervisors shall think proper and thence Eastwardly to such point in the highway running by Spencer Coles to Shopiere as said Supervisors shall deem proper running across lands owned by John P. Fonda, Adam Bell, David H. Randall, Jacob T. Dockstader, William H. Stark, Daniel Smith, T. W. Randall and Spencer Cole, dated September 23, 1856.

Milton S. Warner was absent and Tom H. Starks being legally disabled from serving. The board consisted of Messrs. Read and Van Gelder from LaPrairie and Ellek Bruce and A. T. Bennett from Turtle. Having examined the ground and not being able to agree on the propriety of locating said road, the board adjourned to meet at the house of William H. Starks on Saturday the 8<sup>th</sup> day of November at nine o'clock A.M.
