We the Commissioners of Highways for the Town of Turtle hereby certify that we met at the house of Mosses W. Chapmans in said town on Tuesday the 26th day of May A.D. 1846 at ten o'clock A.M. and upon being satisfied that notice had been given as the law requires of our meeting at such time and place for the purpose of examining the ground on a line petitioned to be laid out as a highway by A. F. Mack and six others known to us to be freeholders in said town. We proceeded to examine the ground on the line petitioned for and caused a survey of the same to be made as follows:

Beginning on the West line of Township No. 1 of Range 13 East of the 4th Meridian in Wisconsin at a stake 2 rods South of the Southeast corner of Section 6; thence running South 89 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° East and parallel with the South line of Section 6, 75 chains and 13 links to a line of Section 8; thence same course parallel with the South line of Section 5, 80 chains and 21 links to a stake 2 rods South of the corner of Sections 4, 5, 8 and 9; thence North 81 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° East 20 chains; thence North 76° 55' East 20 chains and 90 links to the West side of a road on the quarter line of Section 4; thence North 72° 35' East 9 chains and 67 links to a stake in the West line of the East half of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 4, 5 chains and 36 links South its center; thence North 74 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° East 21 chains to the center of a road near A. Allyns.

And we order that the above described line be the center line of a highway four rods wide.
