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We the undersigned Commissioners of Highways for the Towns of Rock and Turtle in the County of Rock, Wisconsin Territory, did examine the ground and lay out a public highway on the range line between Ranges 12 and 13 commencing at the Northeast corner of Section 24, Town 2 Range 12 and running South to the Southeast corner of Section 36 of said town on the 26th day of February, 1848. Said road is situated on the town line between the towns of Rock and Turtle, one half of which is situated in Rock and their half in Turtle and to be four rods wide.

We the said Commissioners have divided said road as follows:

The town of Rock takes the North end of said road as far as the North side of the Big Ravine to the South end of a bridge 20 feet along which is to be built by the Town of Rock.

At the termination of which that part of the said road which belongs to the Town of Turtle commences and continues; thence to the South line of said towns, the town of Turtle is to build at two points in the abovementioned ravine two bridges of ten feet each

We the undersigned Commissioners aforesaid, for the Town of Rock and Turtle do certify that we have laid out the above described road and return the same as a public highway.
