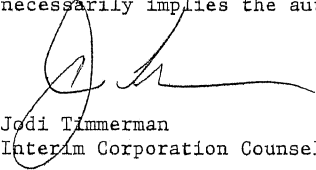

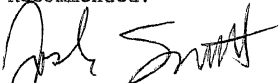

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This resolution authorizes the Rock County Land Conservation Committee to submit an application to the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture Trade and Consumer Protection for the sponsorship of the Clean Sweep Program in 2018. The Land Conservation Committee sponsored the last Clean Sweep Program in 2017.

The Clean Sweep Program provides landowners, small businesses, and units of government an opportunity to dispose of chemicals in a safe manner. Chemicals banned from disposal in the landfill system will be collected through this program. Also, this program allows businesses that are considered Very Small Quantity Generators to pay for the services and dispose of chemicals used in their businesses. All units of government, from schools to cities, will have this option made available to them.

The applications for the 2018 program year will be released in early fall 2017. The actual dates for release and return have not been set by DATCP as of the writing of this resolution.

This program has a grant limit equal to 75% of the costs of the proposed project. The County may match the 25% requirement with cash and/or services provided by Staff for the activities associated with this event. Rock County will develop a grant application for the maximum grant allowed. A majority of these expenses will be incurred through in-kind services provided by the Land Conservation Department.

AMENDING THE LAND CONSERVATION DEPARTMENT BUDGET TO ALLOW FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF GYPSY MOTH PROGRAM FUND BALANCE

1 WHEREAS, the Land Conservation Department has been notified by the City of Beloit that their Urban
2 Forestry program priorities have changed from the Gypsy Moth Suppression Program to tree removal due
3 to mortality by the Emerald Ash Borer; and,

5 WHEREAS, the City of Beloit has requested that their prorated funds from the Gypsy Moth Suppression
6 Fund Balance be reimbursed to assist with their funding for the tree removal in the urban landscape; and

8 WHEREAS, the City of Beloit was a primary contributor to the Gypsy Moth Program fund balance to
9 assure that funding was available for the suppression program, even if federal grants were not; and,

11 WHEREAS, the Land Conservation Department determined the prorated amount due back to the City of
12 Beloit based on program costs, federal grants received, the amount of funding the City of Beloit
13 contributed, and the balance of the fund; and,

15 WHEREAS, the Land Conservation Department needs to amend their 2017 budget to accommodate this
16 request. The current budget does not include the budgetary authority to expend costs associated with the
17 reimbursement.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled
20 this _____ day of _____, 2017, authorizes the Land Conservation Committee to reimburse
21 the City of Beloit the appropriate amount owed from the Gypsy Moth Program Fund Balance; and,

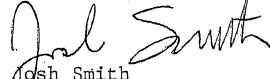

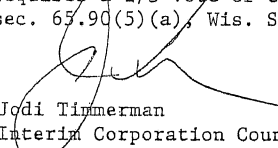

AMENDING THE LAND CONSERVATION DEPARTMENT BUDGET TO ALLOW FOR
REIMBURSEMENT OF GYPSY MOTH PROGRAM FUND BALANCE

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Executive Summary

The City of Beloit has requested reimbursement from the Gypsy Moth Suppression program fund balance in the sum of \$3,553.48. A fund balance was established for this program to assure appropriate funding was available even if federal grants were not available or were not at 100% of the program costs. Due to the Emerald Ash Borer's presence in the urban area of Beloit, the City is experiencing an extremely high Ash Tree mortality rate, which in turn has put a financial stress on the Urban Forestry Budget. All infected ash trees on City owned property need to be removed.

The Gypsy Moth program commenced during 2005, with the first aerial spraying completed in May of 2006. The program continues today with staff from the Land Conservation Department mainly working with private landowner groups outside the first infected areas of the City of Beloit and Town of Beloit. Fund balances continue to fund staff to inventory infected areas to assure the population of this pest remains at a very low level so reinfection of urban and suburban areas doesn't occur.
