

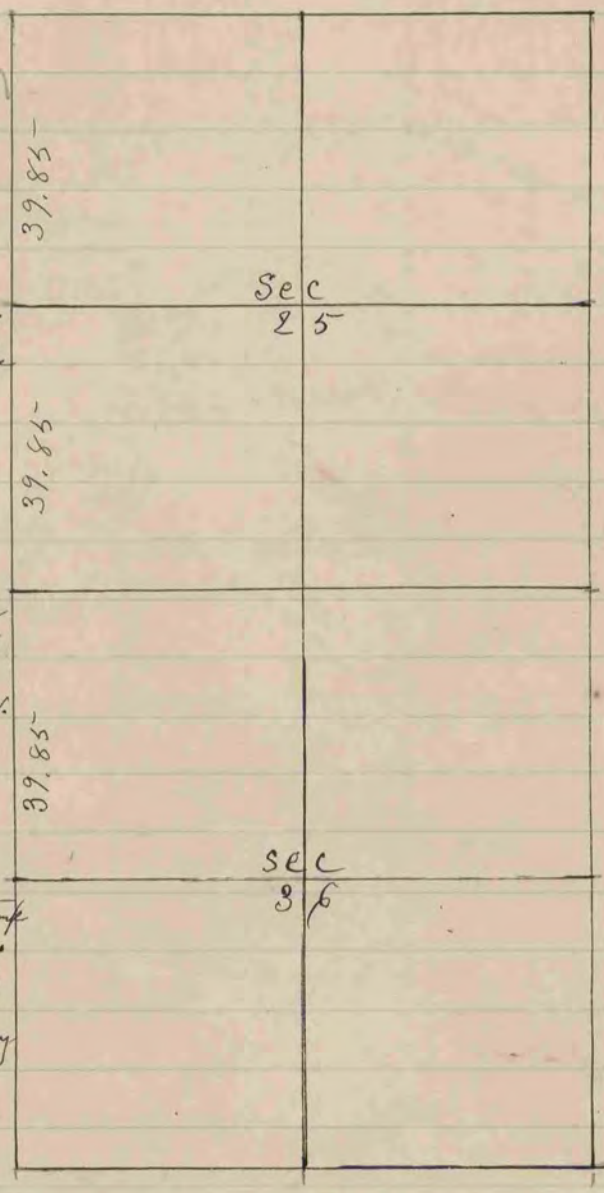
Found stake \odot by 3
limestones one of them
burnt also found stump
of N.W. B. 7.

Mar 3 1882

Found stumps of
both B. 7. & 6 remains of
old stake. Drove new stake
in place of old \odot by 6
cobblestones.

Drove $\frac{3}{4}$ inch iron rod also
drove $\frac{3}{8}$ inch iron rods 18
ft E & W. Drove stake N
of rod at cor. Took B. 7 &
W. 07 N. $5^{\circ} 15'$ W. 2.59. W.
0.8. N. 19° W 29 $1\frac{1}{2}$.

Found stone mark
N. & E. B. 7. & where stump
of S. E. B. 7. had decayed.
Took new B. 7 & Hickory
S. 39 $^{\circ}$ E 32 Bl. O.
S. 46 $^{\circ}$ W 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ Hickory
S. 64 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 49.
