



Description of piece of land sold by Coulton Brothers to Earle & Maltrest.

All that part of the S. E. 1/4 of Section four (4) in town four (4) north of Range twelve (12) East of the Fourth (4th) Principal Meridian included within the following described boundaries, to wit: commencing at an iron coupling pin in the south line of said Section two (2) chains and fifteen & three fourths (15 3/4) links west of the south-east corner of said section, thence North-fifty five & one half (55 1/2) west-six (6) chains & twenty nine (29) links to an iron rod thence North thirty & one half (30 1/2) degrees east four (4) chains and fifty and one half (50 1/2) links to an iron rod, thence North-fifty nine and one half (59 1/2) degrees west-four (4) chains to an iron rod, thence South-sixteen (16) degrees west nine (9) chains & twenty nine (29) links to the place of beginning. <sup>is a stake in the S.E. corner of section 8.94 3/4 ch</sup> Containing three and eighty two hundredths 3 82/100 acres of land more or less.
