



Found S.W. B.T. stump & where N.W. B.T. stump had been dug up it is 7.76 to the latter instead of 7.56 as in the notes. Both stumps agree as to bearing set points of limestone 27 x 22 x 5 pointed

Found sand stone & old stake on south side of stone. also stumps of N.E. B.T. & S.W. B.T. Probe off sandstone & set on top of old stake & sandstone a hard head stone 16 x 12 x 9 & surrounded it by sandstone

Found remains of old stake & stump of S.W. B.T. where stump of N.E. B.T. had been dug up set large stake in place of old one.

Drum stake & leaf B.T. B.T. O.G.N. 48° W 64' E B.T. O. 41.71° W 70' E

Found purple sandstone & where B.T. stumps had been dug up - put in place of sand stone limestone 29 x 8 x 7 & surrounded by 2 h. & sandstone - put in place of N.W. B.T. large 27. & in place of S.E. B.T. pointed hard head stone.

set pointed limestone 20 x 9 x 5 1/2 - pt B.T. B.T. O. 85.37 1/2 S 25 1/4 B.T. O. 85.30 1/2

Found N.E. B.T. stump where S.E. B.T. stump had been dug out. There were 2 small stones at corner under ground. Set hard head stone 28 x 17 x 11 took from B.T. B.T. O. 10 N 80° E 71 1/2

Found where both B.T. had decayed in ground also line tree 6.64 5' cor. all three brought corner at one place. Set place of N.E. B.T. stump 8 ft h. 32 x 21 x 20. & at place of S.W. B.T. put hh 24 x 18 x 19 Drove iron rod & put line & sandstone around & over it.

set pointed limestone 23 x 13 x 5 point up.

Found stumps of both B.T. set sand stone 24 x 16 x 2 1/2
