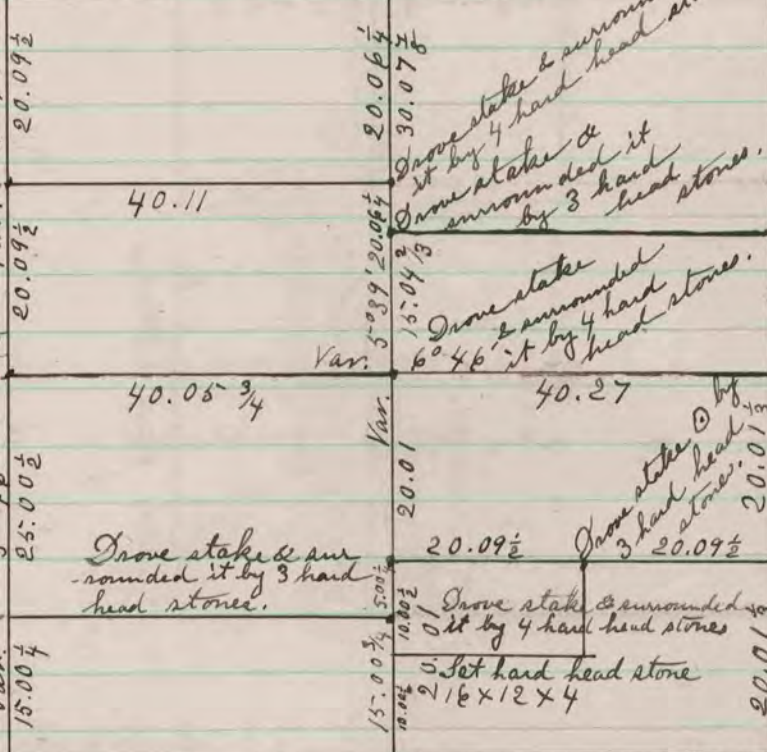


Found remains of old stake & stump of N.E. B. 7. & where stump of S.W. B. 7. had been dug up. Set lime stone 22x7x3 & surrounded it by 4 hard head stones.

Found N.W. B. 7. and stump of S.W. B. 7. corner in ditch of road washed out. Drove stake at corner & surrounded stake by 4 hard head stones.



Found old stake & stump of N.W. B. 7. Stumps of the other B. 7s dug out. Set lime stone 18x12x2 & surrounded it by 4 hard head stones.

Found old stake & where stump of both B. 7s had been dug up. Drove stake & surrounded it with 3 hard head stones - but notches in board fence where town line crosses it.

Found where stump of B. 7 to corner for Fulton had been dug up. The corner for Fulton is 40 links W. of corner for Ganesville - Black Oak tree 7 inches in diameter at corner for Fulton - Marked said tree by cutting 3 hacks on each of the 4 sides thereof.

Found stake & stump of S.W. B. 7. & where stump of S.E. B. 7. had been dug up. Set stake & surrounded it by 3 hard head stones.

Drove stake & surrounded it by 4 hard head stones.

Found hard head stone on corner for Ganesville also found where stump of both B. 7s had been dug up. Set hard head stone 32x20x9.
