I hereby certify this to be a correct plat; and the following to be a correct record of a survey made by me April 30th 1877 of the section line between the south west quarter of section 30 and the north west quarter of Section 31 of the town of Bradford to ascertain whether any portion of Mr Lamphiere's House extended south of said section line. From the S.W. cor. & also from the south $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of Sec. 30. I offsetted south 60 links & run a right line between said offsetted points with an Engineer's transit, and at determined points in said line opposite & adjacent to either side of the house, then offsetted north from said points 60 links and established monuments in said

between eighties.
section line at points A & B. shown on the plat; I found that at the East face of the main building of Lamphiere's house said main part of the house or building extended south of the section line 5 ft. & 3 inches & including the verandah 10 ft & 5 inches & that at the west face of said main part or building it extended south of the section line 5 feet & 9 inches & including the verandah 10 feet & 11 inches.
The monument at A consists of a lime stone 18 in. long by 9 in. wide, by 3 in. thick, surrounded by a lot of small hard head stones. The monument is on the section line & 1.45 chs. west of line between Eighties & 8 $\frac{1}{4}$ links East of East face of East wing of house produced.
The monument at B, consists of a lime stone 14 in. long by 6 in. wide, by 3 in. thick, surrounded by 4 hard head stones. It is on said section line & 3 feet & 9 in. west of west face of west wing of house produced.
