



Found lime stone at cor. Mr. Daniel Sumner's dis says that Frank Mitchell, S. M. Davis, & Bennett placed himself put the stone in the place of the old stake in the mound. thinks that the stone is 30x12x2 - the above is for the N.E. cor. of Sec 1, T. 1, R. 8.

Found the E. 1/2 cor. of Sec. 1, T. 1, R. 8 as set by stumps correct. turned off & found remains of both P. Y. stumps - they both were in the right direction & the right distances from the cor. Found limestone at cor. about 30x9x4

Established S.W. cor. of sec. 6. town 1 Range 9. at a point 190 N. of S.E. cor. of sec 1. town 1 range 8 - The P. Y. stumps would come under the E. abutment of small highway bridge - set h. h. stone 14x12x7.

Found large irregular pointed h. h. stone 22x18x4 & found under it remains of old stake also - French stake, 4. W. they under to his son Harry are said to have put in the stone in the place of the old stake in the mound.

Found large p. h. stone at cor said to have been put in place of old stake by French, Lake & W. Newman.
