



Found remains of old stake & remains of the stumps of both B. & C.

The above is a record & plat of a survey made by me on Sec. 8 Town 3, Range 9 from Jan. 10-14 inclusive 1884.

Surveyed the N & S. $\frac{1}{4}$ line of Sec. 15 town of Johnstown & drove stakes every 40 rods. along said $\frac{1}{4}$ line to define the center line of highway - also drove stakes $37\frac{1}{2}$ lks. E. & W. of said N. & S. $\frac{1}{4}$ line at the center of the Sec. & at the N. line of the S. $\frac{1}{2}$ of the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of said sec. drove stake $37\frac{1}{2}$ lks. W. of said $\frac{1}{4}$ line. These stakes refer to the highway & have nothing to do with land corners. At the S. $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of said Sec. found cor. as set by self in former survey - see page 784. At N. $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of said sec. found the remains of both of the stumps of the B. & C. The road has been dug down so that all traces of old stake were gone - set H. H. stone 12x8x4 & it by 4 H. H. stones & 1 lime stone. Surveyed Feb. 12. 1884.
