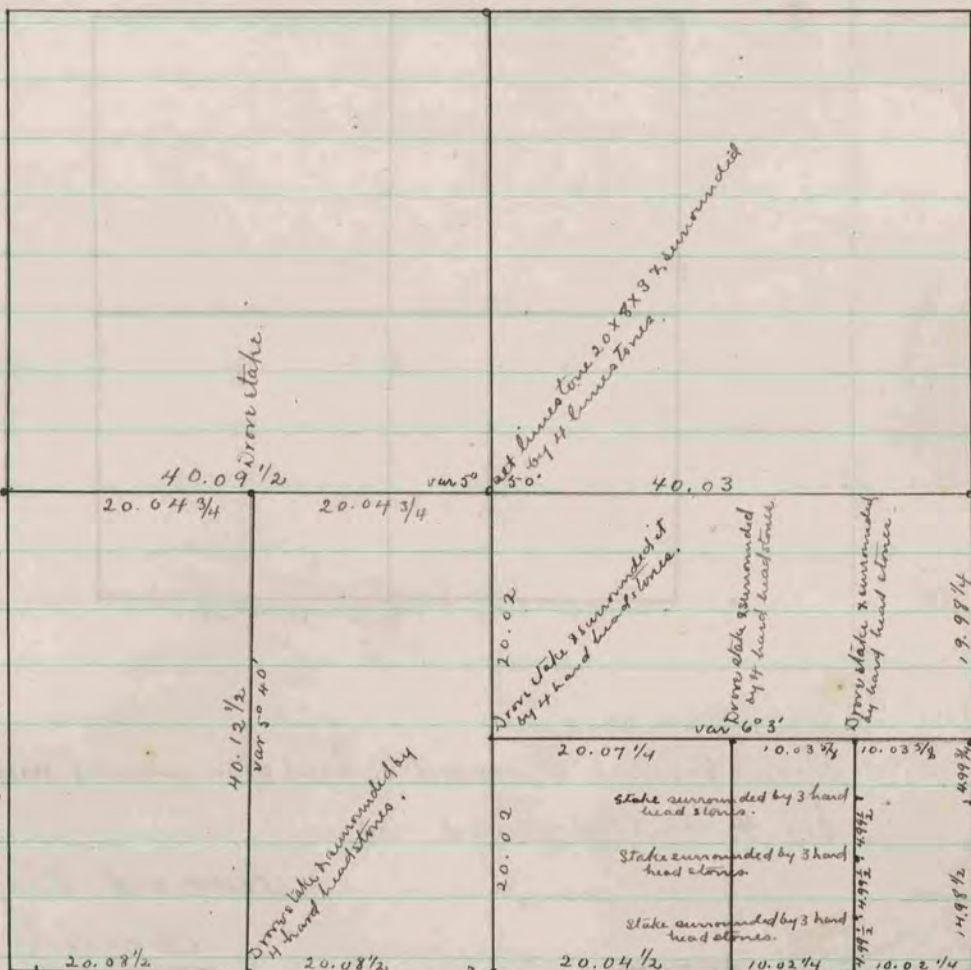

Drove stake & surrounded by 4 hand headstones.

Set line 14 x 5 x 5 and surrounded by 4 hand headstones.
