I hereby certify that the following is a correct record of said survey as made by me.

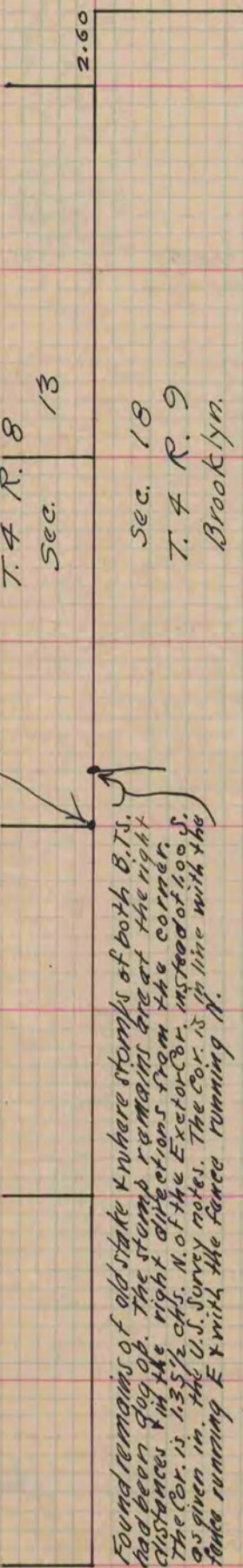

Found stumps of both B.T.s. The Cor. as found from the B.T.s. stumps is in line with fence running N. 4 in line with fence running S. on Town Line. It is about 4 in N. of the N. fence part of the fence running S. There are 2 trees left standing near the line between Secs 13 & 14 which had evidently been blazed in the U.S. Survey

Found remains of old stake & where stumps of both B.T.s. had been dug up. The stump remains at the right distance & in the right direction from the corner. The Cor. is 1.35 1/2 chs. N. of the Exeter Cor. instead of 100 S. as given in the U.S. Survey notes. The Cor. is in line with the fence running E & X with the fence running N.
