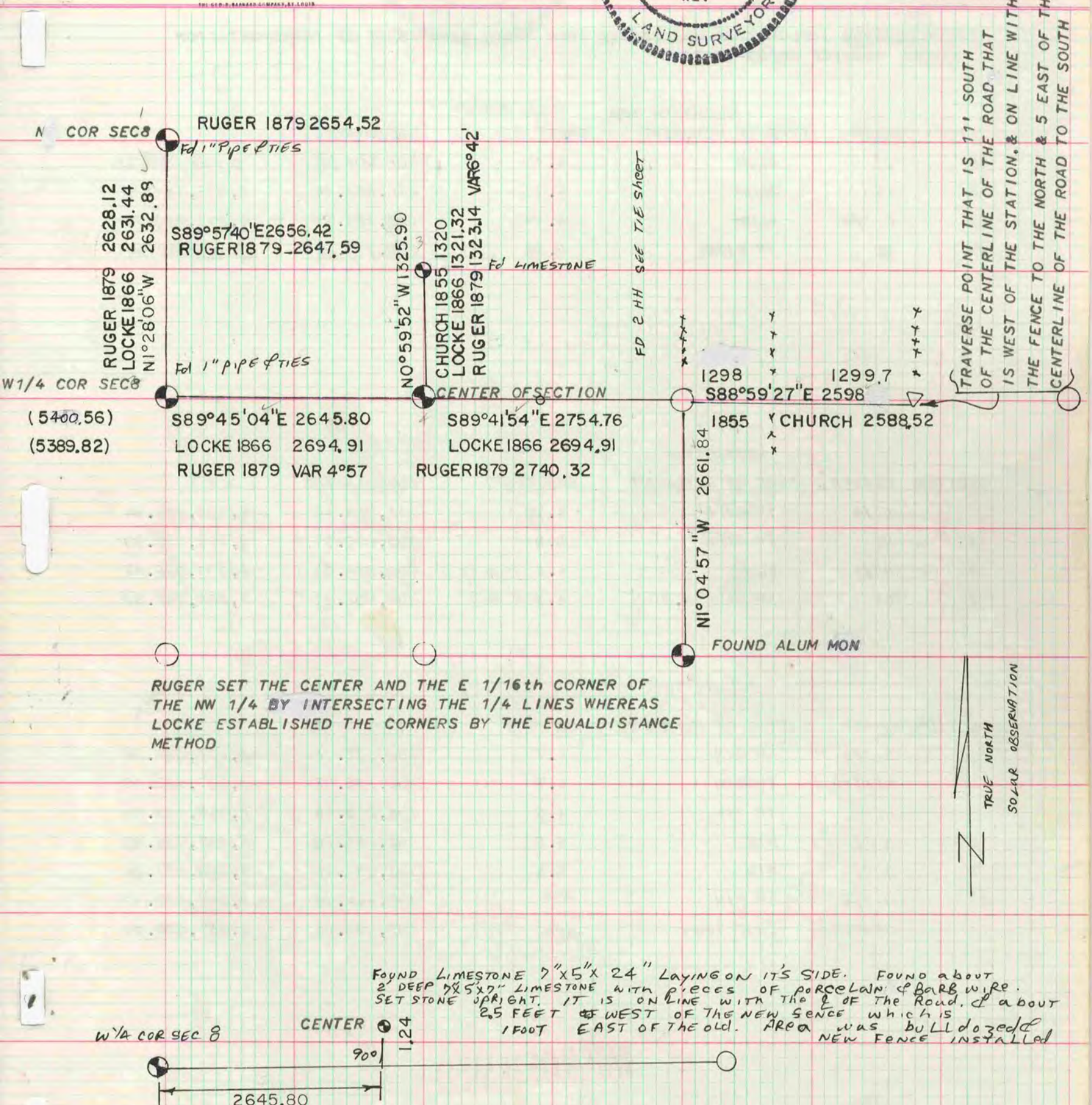

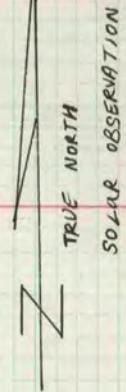

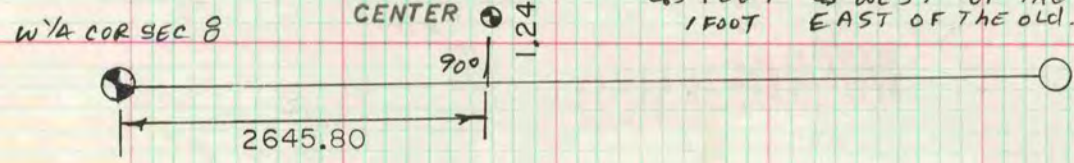


TRAVERSE POINT THAT IS 11' SOUTH OF THE CENTERLINE OF THE ROAD THAT IS WEST OF THE STATION, & ON LINE WITH THE FENCE TO THE NORTH & 5 EAST OF THE CENTERLINE OF THE ROAD TO THE SOUTH

RUGER SET THE CENTER AND THE E 1/16th CORNER OF THE NW 1/4 BY INTERSECTING THE 1/4 LINES WHEREAS LOCKE ESTABLISHED THE CORNERS BY THE EQUALDISTANCE METHOD



FOUND LIMESTONE 7"X5"X 24" LAYING ON ITS SIDE. FOUND ABOUT 2' DEEP 5X5" LIMESTONE WITH PIECES OF PORCELAIN & BARB WIRE. SET STONE UPRIGHT. IT IS ON LINE WITH THE E OF THE ROAD. & ABOUT 2.5 FEET WEST OF THE NEW SENCE WHICH IS 1 FOOT EAST OF THE OLD. AREA WAS BULLDOZED & NEW FENCE INSTALLED
