Subdivision of a Section.

Sir:

In reply to your question dated September 5, 1908, referring to the legal method of establishing the center quarter-corner of a section, and the different way followed by a county surveyor of 50 years ago, you are advised that the straight-line method, which is according to law, often fails to subdivide an irregular section equitably, yet no general rule has yet been devised or enacted which would be of universal application.

Your perplexity in the matter of amending the subdivision work of the early surveyor, will be relieved by consulting the statute of limitations (Wisconsin statutes, section 4207), which renders now valid the lines of subdivision then irregularly established.
