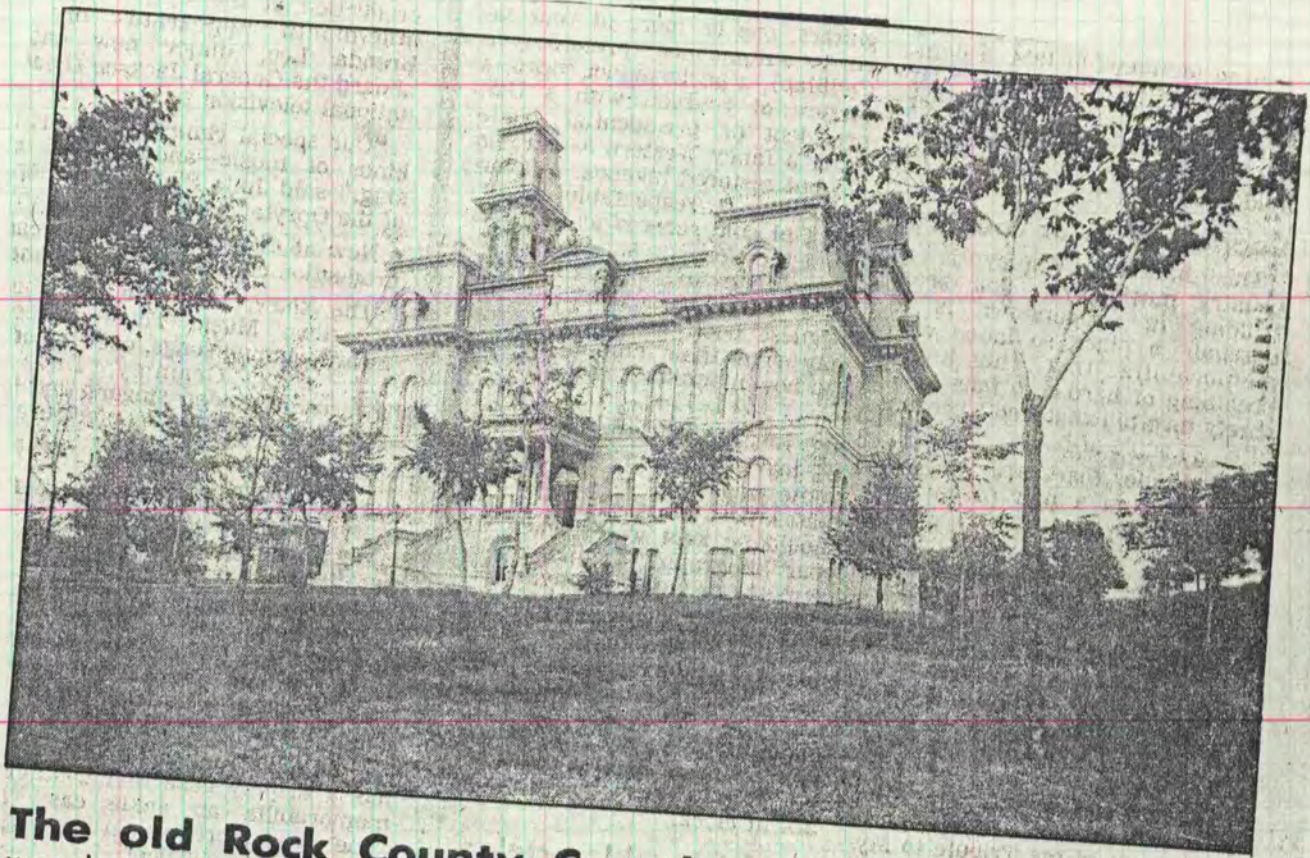

The old Rock County Courthouse

was designed by Edward T. Mix, a Milwaukee architect, who was probably the best known 19th century architect in Wisconsin. The courthouse, which was located at the present site of the courthouse parking lot, was built in 1869. It was torn down after the current one was built in 1955. Actually, there were three courthouses. The first one burned down in 1859, leaving the county without a courthouse for 10 years.
