



Turtle Creek Parkway County Park:

This picturesque 3.5 acre park lies along the Turtle Creek, and features a fantastic view of the historic

Five Arch Stone Bridge, open green space and a single story building for rent.

Location:

Turtle Creek Parkway is located 10 miles northeast of the City of Beloit at 6528 S. Smith Road.

Amenities:

Include picnic tables, building available for rent, drinking water, restroom facilities, and parking. In an effort to keep the area clean, dumpsters are provided. Chairs and tables provided for 100 people.



Historic Five Arch Stone Bridge:

The Tiffany Stone Bridge was built in 1869, designed by the chief engineer of the Chicago & Northwestern Railway Company, Van Mienen. It is the country's only remaining five-arch bridge.

Turtle Creek Building:

Host your family reunion, graduation party, wedding, or picnic here. The building is rented through the Rock County Parks Department. Rentals must be made if you plan to use the building and electricity. 608-757-5450



