Supporting Aggressive Action to Prevent Asian Carp from Entering Lake Michigan and Great Lakes Watersheds

- 1 WHEREAS, many jobs and major investments in Wisconsin depend on the health of the Lake 2 Michigan watershed eco-system; and,
- 4 WHEREAS, Asian Carp may consume up to half their weight daily in plankton and are likely to decimate the lake resources that native species depend upon; and,
- WHEREAS, Asian Carp have been moving up the Mississippi River system toward the Great Lakes since they escaped decades ago from ponds in Arkansas and they are now poised to enter Lake
- 9 Michigan through the Chicago Sanitary Canal or through the Des Plaines river flooding; and,
- WHEREAS, history with devastating invasive species like zebra mussels and lamprey eels teaches that preventing entry is imperative as well as cost effective; and,
- WHEREAS, once invasive species enter the great lakes, they soon become problems in inland rivers and lakes too; and,
- WHEREAS, it is likely that there is still time to prevent a breeding population of carp from getting established, thus harming the lake and the livelihood of the people who rely on it.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled this day of Mach. 2010 support pursuing every reasonable legal means available to protect Wisconsin and Great Lakes water systems from invasive carp, including support of the lawsuit in the US Supreme Court to temporarily close the shipping locks near Chicago and create new stormflood barriers; and,
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Rock County Board of Supervisors that the Rock County Clerk is directed to transmit a copy of this Resolution to the President of the United States, Rock County's federal legislative delegation, the Governor of the State of Wisconsin, the Wisconsin Attorney General, Rock County's state legislative delegation, all Wisconsin Counties, and the
- 30 Wisconsin Counties Association.
