#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Rock County Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC) received an increase from Wisconsin Emergency Management for the 2011 EPCRA Planning Grant. The LEPC portion of the Emergency Management office works on a federal fiscal year that overlaps two calendar years. Thus, twenty-five percent covers the 2010 allocation and seventy-five percent covers the 2011 allocation. The total allocation increased by 6.4%.

The new fiscal year that this program covers starts October 2010 and runs through September 2011.
