#### **Executive Summary**

The Sheriff's Office has been awarded a \$50,000 grant from the High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) Program, a program administered by the Office of National Drug Control Policy (ONDCP). The purpose of the Program is to reduce drug trafficking and drug production in the United States.

The HIDTA Program provides funding resources to joint initiatives of federal, state, local, and tribal agencies in each area designated as a HIDTA to carry out activities that address the specific drug threats of those areas.

The grant funds will be used for overtime, investigative expenses, and equipment. The equipment purchased will be used for observation and undercover operations. Specific equipment to be purchased has not been determined at this time
