# Executive Summary Authorizing Purchase of Motorola CAD Software Upgrade for 911 Communications Center

The law enforcement, fire, and EMS agencies of Rock County have utilized the existing mobile data system since 2001. In 2013, The Rock Communications Center upgraded their Computer-Aided Dispatch Software in preparation for Next Generation 9-1-1. The CAD upgrade has created several limitations to the existing mobile data software.

Motorola has developed improved mobile data software that tightly interfaces with the Communications Center's existing CAD software. The new software will enhance communication between 9-1-1 and police, fire and EMS laptop computers, provide mapping capabilities, and notify officers of premise hazard information.

This resolution authorizes Rock County to contract with Motorola for a new Mobile Data server, Mobile Data server software, and 158 client licenses at a cost of \$294,221.
