Executive Summary

Amending the 2014 Highway Budget for Replacement of Highway Patrol Truck

The purpose of this Resolution is to amend the Cost Pools acquisition of capital assets budget to authorize the purchase of one additional vehicle and related attachments.

Authority to replace highway patrol truck 1042, totaled in 12/20/2013 rollover accident, and related attached equipment of plow, spreader and wing. Insurance proceeds of \$204,944.45 should substantially fund this additional purchase authority.
