EXEUTIVE SUMMARY

Rock County is the owner of the Rock County Fairgrounds. The 4-H Fairgrounds property consists of 18.5 acres located at 1301 Craig Avenue, Janesville. The County of Rock is responsible for the capital improvements, repair and maintenance of the grounds and facilities.

The Craig Center is the only building that is heated and available for rent throughout the year. Rental income directly from the use of the Craig Center for various events and activities totals approximately \$16,000 annually. Rental income is used to partially offset operational cost of the fairgrounds.

The Craig Center boiler is in need of major repair or replacement. The cost to repair the existing boiler is prohibitive the given its age and condition. Replacement of the boiler is the most fiscally responsible decision.

The lowest bid was submitted by Tri-Cor Mechanical, Janesville, Wisconsin, in the amount of \$10,149.00. Project to be completed by February 27, 2015.
