### **FISCAL NOTE:**

This resolution authorizes an Intergovernmental Agreement between Rock County and the City of Beloit whereby the City of Beloit will maintain the section of CTH G between Huebbe Parkway and Philhower Road as well as maintain the street lighting at Inman Parkway. In return, Rock County will pay a portion of its General Transportation Aids to the City. This amount is estimated to be approximately \$12,256 annually.

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

With the upcoming Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) I-39/90 project, an alternate route has been identified on CTH S (Shopiere Road), CTH BT (to be constructed), CTH G (Prairie Avenue) and STH 11. CTH G is scheduled to be reconstructed in 2015. With this reconstruction of CTH G, a segment between Huebbe Parkway and Philhower Road will become an urban corridor with curb & gutter, sidewalk, street lighting, storm sewer, and traffic signals at Inman Parkway.

This resolution authorizes an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement between Rock County and the City of Beloit for the maintenance of CTH G between Huebbe Parkway and Philhower Road. This section of road is 1.32 miles in length and is partially within the City Limits.

The County has agreed to install the urban type improvements, including street lighting, consistent with City of Beloit standards, on this segment of roadway as part of the project. The City of Beloit agrees to take on maintenance responsibilities; including operation, maintenance and repair of the street lights and traffic signal at Inman Parkway of this partial roadway corridor and further agrees this roadway will remain marked and signed as CTH G. The County will recover the cost of the street lighting due to reduced road maintenance costs.

The County will pay a proportionate amount of its General Transportation Aids to the City in a ratio of this segment length to the total mileage of all County Highways. The County currently has 212.60 certified miles in its system. Based on 2014 data, the annual payment from the County to the City for this road segment will be \$12,256.25. The County will retain ownership of the road and the adjoining local governments (City and Town of Beloit) will continue to have the ability to create and enforce their own land use regulations and enforce traffic and other laws within their jurisdictions. When the roadway is in need of reconstruction or major repairs, it will be the responsibility of the County.
