With hearing loss, one of the most common disabilities, hearing loops are an extremely cost efficient and convenient way of providing assistance to those hearing impaired patrons who use hearing aids or have cochlear implants. The Arrowhead Library System (ALS) has been awarded a 2015 LSTA Public Library System Accessibility in Public Libraries Grant to install a total of three meeting/program room hearing loop systems. These Hearing loop systems are to be installed in the Beloit, Edgerton and Hedberg (Janesville) Public Libraries.
