# APPROVE RELOCATION ORDER FOR CTH H

The rehabilitation of CTH H (USH 14 – CTH M) is scheduled to be completed in 2015. To complete proposed modifications to the alignment of CTH H, the County must acquire certain interests in land in Section 7 of the Town of Janesville. It is required by Statute that the County Board pass a relocation order as the first legal step in the process.

This resolution adopts the relocation order and delegates responsibility for implementation to the Public Works Committee and Director of Public Works.
