Awarding Contract for Demolition of the Rock County Courthouse Tower

WHEREAS, the Courthouse tower was constructed in 1998, as a prominent architectural feature reminiscent of towers on two of the three Rock County Courthouses built on this site; and,

WHEREAS, Structural Research Inc. (SRI) was hired to develop options for addressing the brick deterioration issues; and,

WHEREAS, after reviewing the options to repair and retain the tower, the General Services Committee voted 3-0 on September 9, 2014 to take the tower down; and,

WHEREAS, funds were included in the 2015 budget to prepare the plans and specifications, and seek bids for demolition.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled this 10th day of September, 2015, that a contract to demolish the Courthouse tower be awarded to L&M Trucking of Wrightstown, WI in the amount of \$\$142,700.00: and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a project contingency in the amount of \$20,000 be established to cover change orders approved by the General Services Committee; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that payments be made to the vendor upon approval of the General Services Committee.

Executive Summary

Retaining Firm to Prepare Plans and Specifications for Demolition of the Courthouse Tower

In 1994, the County Board endorsed the design for the 76,000 square foot Courthouse addition, including its colonnades, balconies, arched roof, two parking structures, and the tower. As an architectural feature, the tower was reminiscent of towers on two of Rock County's past Courthouses.

In 2011, the brick on the upper portion of the tower began to show signs of freeze thaw damage. Structural Research Inc. (SRI) was hired to assess the tower, and develop options for addressing the problem. Five options for restoration of the tower were presented, along with the demolition option. The General Services Committee sought public input on whether or not to keep the tower. The three opinions received from neighbors, favored tearing the tower down.

On September 9^{th} , 2014, the General Services Committee voted 3-0 to remove, and not restore the tower. The low bid for the work was submitted by L & M Trucking of Wrightstown, WI. With an estimated start date of 9/20, the contractor listed a completion date of 11/1.
