## - Executive Summary -Recognizing Efforts of the Friends of Beckman Mill, Incorporated, at Beckman Mill County Park on Their 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary

Rock County started its long-term relationship with the Friends of Beckman Mill, Incorporated June 1, 1991. The first lease agreement expired in May 2001 and was renewed through 2013.

The Friends of Beckman Mill, Incorporated, have vigorously pursued other grant funding sources and have successfully been awarded well over \$100,000 in grant funds from various organizations. Such organizations have included Society for the Preservation of Old Mills (SPOOM), Wisconsin Power & Light, Ashcraft Foundation, Greater Beloit Community Foundation, Questers, Lutheran Brotherhood, Harnischfeger, Inc., Kohler Foundation, Janesville Foundation, Beloit Foundation, Ressler Mill Foundation, Wisconsin DNR, and Whitetails Unlimited.

The Friends have restored the Howe-Beckman Mill, the cooperage, and constructed a creamery, a visitors' center, and a barn and reconstructed the spillway (mill pond dam) and fish passage on the West Fork of Raccoon Creek.

Each year, the Friends of Beckman Mill, Incorporated, have also held numerous fund raising activities bringing many people to visit this park. They also give tours of the Park and do many hours of volunteer maintenance of the mill, buildings and grounds.

We look forward to a continued successful partnership with a truly exemplary and outstanding group of volunteers.
