<u>Authorizing a Contract with Baker Tilly to Conduct a Finance Department Organizational</u> <u>Structure and Operations Assessment</u>

WHEREAS, the 2022 budget included funding to contract with a consultant to conduct a review of the Finance Department's organizational structure and operations; and

WHEREAS, over the years, the Finance Department has made a number of changes to its organizational structure that have improved efficiencies and reduced costs; and

WHEREAS, in recent years, the Finance Department has taken on additional duties, including supervising accounting staff in the Department of Public Works and payroll functions for Rock Haven; and

WHEREAS, Baker Tilly, the County's external financial auditor, has made recommendations regarding internal controls and the completion of the financial audits; and

WHEREAS, contracting with Baker Tilly's public sector team to conduct this review will leverage the knowledge of the Baker Tilly financial audit team while coordinating with the Baker Tilly team facilitating the strategic planning process for the County, resulting in increased efficiency in these organizational improvement efforts; and

WHEREAS, work would commence in May 2022 and be completed in time for possible incorporation into the 2023 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled this <u>24th</u> day of <u>March</u>, 2022, does hereby authorize a contract with Baker Tilly in the amount of \$20,000 to conduct a review of the Finance Department's organizational structure and operations.
