Becker began her employment with Rock County on February 5, 1996, as a Clerk Typist III in the Rock County Sheriff's Office working in the Front Office working both first and second shifts. Grace Becker resigned from the Sheriff's Office on February 7, 2001, and took a position of Legal Stenographer with the Rock County District Attorney's Office. On January 28, 2002, she returned to the Sheriff's Office as a Secretary II for the Law Enforcement Services Commander. On June 7, 2010, Grace was promoted to Administrative Secretary to the Sheriff and Chief Deputy; and

WHEREAS, throughout her tenure with the Sheriff's Office, Administrative Secretary Grace Becker has served in many capacities including: a member of the first Jail Transition Team, worked with other Law Enforcement Secretaries in Rock County to develop a universal data input system for cases in LRMS, and helped in the development of the County Filing System with Assistant to the County Administrator Randy Terronez and Captain Gary Groelle; and
