If you accept responsibility for the crime you are accused of and can make a commitment to no new violations then you <u>may</u> be eligible for DVIP.

The DVIP Office is located on Floor 4R. You will take the elevator beyond security to 4R. Take a left out of the elevator and a right down the hallway; walk straight ahead to the next set of stairs and go up those stairs. Our office is on the right. It is handicap accessible.

- <u>Domestic Violence Intervention Program</u> (DVIP) <u>may</u> be available to individuals charged, as an adult, with a domestic violence offense. DVIP involves attending small group or individual sessions. Upon completion of DVIP you will receive some consideration in Court on the charge and/or fine *per the plea agreement with the District Attorney*.
- When appropriate, there may be additional requirements necessary to complete DVIP. Those
 requirements will be determined at your initial assessment interview. Examples of requirements
 that could become part of a DVIP contract include:

Restitution · Alcohol & Drug Assessment/Chapter 20 Assessment (with treatment, if recommended) · Anger Management Counseling · Individual Counseling · Parenting Classes · Community Service · or any other available programming/treatment the counselor deems appropriate

There are no program fees required to participate in the Domestic Violence Intervention Program (DVIP). The only costs involved are any restitution owed on a participant's case; and/or if a participant is referred out to a community partner for required services.
