WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Justice, Division of Criminal Investigation (DCI), has been selected as a recipient of the 2023 COPS Office Anti-Heroin Task Force; and,

WHEREAS, the Rock County Sheriff's Office has been invited to be part of the Task Force; and,

WHEREAS, the purpose of the grant is to allocate additional resources for local, multi-jurisdictional, drug task forces; and,

WHEREAS, the Rock County Sheriff's Office is eligible to receive \$10,000 for participating in this grant; and,

WHEREAS, grant funds will be used for overtime wages; and,

WHEREAS, the grant does not require a local match; and,

WHEREAS, the grant runs from January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Rock County Board of Supervisors assembled this <u>26th</u> day of <u>January 2023</u>, that the Rock County Sheriff is authorized to accept funds under the Anti-Heroin Task Force Grant.

The purpose of the grant is to allocate additional resources for local, multi-jurisdictional, drug task forces. Reimbursement will be provided to agencies, for overtime pay expenses, incurred during heroin and opiate investigations.

The Rock County Sheriff's Office is eligible to receive \$10,000 for participating in this grant. The grant funds will be used for overtime wages only. Benefits will not be reimbursed. The grant does not require a local match. The grant runs from January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023.
