Retired Rock County Sheriff's Office K9 Sasha, formerly assigned to Sergeant Nathan DeBoer, passed away on February 20, 2023, after being diagnosed with lymphoma.

Sasha started active duty in August 2013 and was primarily assigned to the Patrol Bureau. Sasha also worked with the SWAT Team and the Special Investigations Unit. She also assisted Sergeant DeBoer by performing sniffs for narcotics at schools, assisting in apprehending multiple suspects for a range of crimes, and diligently searching and locating missing persons. In total, Sasha conducted over 150 tracks and over 600 drug related searches before her retirement on January 4, 2022.

Sasha was a significant asset to the Sheriff's Office and received numerous commendations and letters of appreciation for her work. Sasha served this County with great enthusiasm and was spoken highly of by her fellow Deputies that she protected. Sasha was the best partner that Sergeant DeBoer ever had the Sgt. Nathan DeBoer and K9 Sasha pleasure of working with.
