

Slow-No-Wake Speed Restriction Posted on Rock River

According to the US Geological Survey Gauge in Afton, the water level for the Rock River is currently 7.08 feet. County Ordinance requires a slow-no-wake speed restriction be placed on the portion of the Rock River downstream from the Indianford Dam to the W B R Townline Road Bridge when water levels exceed 6.50 feet.

Thus, the Rock County Sheriff's Office is providing public notice of the slow-no-wake speed restriction on this portion of the river. Deputies will begin posting slow-no-wake signs along the Rock River at all public access points between the Indianford Dam and the WBR Townline Road Bridge.
