Authorizing the Human Services Department to Enter Into Contract with Integrity Residential Services

WHEREAS, the Human Services Department (HSD) operates community-based programs for adults with mental illness, substance abuse, or a co-occurring diagnosis focused on removing barriers to independence and improving quality of life; and,

WHEREAS, to meet consumer needs, HSD contracts with multiple residential agencies to provide an array of supportive-living options to best meet the needs of the individuals needing services; and,

WHEREAS, HSD recommends entering into a contract with Integrity Residential Services for residential services for \$225,000.00 for a level of supervision necessary to meet the needs of individuals served in the community-based programs; and,

WHEREAS, services are provided in compliance with the Administrative Codes and State Statutes that regulate residential settings, and HSD provides a level of oversight to manage the health and safety of the individuals receiving these services; and,

WHEREAS, HSD will be entering into a new contract with Integrity Residential Services for 2023; and.

WHEREAS, Integrity Residential Services has office locations in Dane County and they provide services throughout Dane County; and,

WHEREAS, funds are included in the 2023 HSD Adopted budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled this 13th day of April, 2023, does authorize the Human Services Department to enter into a contract with Integrity Residential Services for an amount up to \$225,000.00 for 2023 for residential services to meet the needs of high needs clients from Rock County.
