# For Reclassification of 1.0 FTE Administrative Services Supervisor And 3.0 FTE Job Center Support Specialists

WHEREAS, the Rock County Human Services Department (RCSHD) is requesting reclassification of four positions with similar roles and responsibilities to other positions in the department; and,

**WHEREAS**, RCHSD requests that a 1.0 FTE Administrative Services Supervisor position is reclassified to a 1.0 FTE Support Services Supervisor; and,

**WHEREAS**, RCHSD requests that 3.0 FTE Job Center Support Specialist positions be reclassified as 3.0 FTE Administrative Assistants and;

WHEREAS, these positions were all previously located at the Rock County Job Center prior to the move to the Dr. Daniel Hale Williams Rock County Resource Center (DWRC), and;

WHEREAS, due to operational changes since the move to the DWRC the job duties of these four positions have become consistent with other positions within RCHSD; and,

WHEREAS, RCHSD is able to absorb the additional cost of approximately \$2,500 for the remainder of 2023 due to recent vacancies in the Job Center Support Specialist positions.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled this <u>27th</u> day of <u>April</u>, 2023 does hereby approve the reclassification of a 1.0 FTE Administrative Services Supervisor position to a 1.0 FTE Support Services Supervisor and 3.0 FTE Job Center Support Specialists to 3.0 FTE Administrative Assistants in the Rock County Human Services Department.
