Slow-No-Wake Speed Restriction Lifted on North Portion of the Rock River

The slow-no-wake status for the portion of the Rock River between the Indianford Dam and Lake Koshkonong is being lifted. The water level for Lake Koshkonong is 7.99 feet. County Ordinance requires a slow-no-wake speed restriction be placed on the portion of the Rock River between the Indianford Dam and Lake Koshkonong when water levels exceed 8.00 feet on Lake Koshkonong.

According to the US Geological Survey Gauge in Afton, the water level for the Rock River is currently 7.26 feet. County Ordinance requires a slow-no-wake speed restriction be placed on the portion of the Rock River downstream from the Indianford Dam to the W B R Townline Road Bridge when water levels exceed 6.50 feet.

According to the US Geological Survey Gauge in Afton, the water level for the Rock River is currently 7.26 feet, which is below the 8.50 feet slow-no-wake County Ordinance requirement for the portion of the Rock River between W B R Townline Road Bridge and the Stateline. Therefore, this portion of the Rock River will remain without slow-no-wake restriction.
