Slow-No-Wake Speed Restriction Lifted on the Rock River

The slow-no-wake status for the portion of the Rock River between the Indianford Dam and W B R Townline Road Bridge has been lifted, so the entire Rock River in Rock County is without a slow-no-wake speed restriction.

According to the US Geological Survey Gauge in Afton, the water level for the Rock River is currently 6.34 feet, which is below the 6.50 feet slow-no-wake County Ordinance requirement for the portion of the Rock River between the Indianford Dam and W B R Townline Road Bridge, resulting in this change. The portion of the Rock River from the Stateline to the W B R Townline Road Bridge remains unrestricted as the water level is below the 8.50 feet slow-no-wake County Ordinance requirement for this portion.

According to the US Geological Survey Gauge in Newville, the water level for the Rock River is currently 7.27 feet, which is below the 8.00 feet slow-no-wake County Ordinance requirement for the portion of the Rock River between Indianford Dam and Lake Koshkonong. Therefore, this portion of the Rock River remains without slow-no-wake.
