On June 6, 2023 at approximately 6:30 p.m. Rock County Sheriff's Deputies were advised of a vehicle traveling westbound on West State Highway 81 by South Nelson Road in the Town of Avon, Rock County, Wisconsin with two flat tires. The vehicle was reported to be driving all over the road, then stopped in the middle of the road. The vehicle continued westbound and struck a mailbox in the 18000 block of West State Highway 81. A Rock County Sheriff's Deputy arrived on scene and identified the driver as 56 year old Kimberly Love from Brodhead, Wisconsin. Kimberly showed signs of impairment and was subsequently arrested for OWI. Kimberly has three prior OWI convictions in Wisconsin and one in Indiana making this her fifth offense, a felony in Wisconsin. Kimberly will be held in the Rock County Jail pending an initial court appearance.
