FOODSHARE WISCONSIN

FoodShare helps people with limited money buy the food they need for good health. Eligible recipients receive a Wisconsin QUEST card which is used like a bank card and can be used at any grocery or convenience store which accepts FoodShare.

The maximum monthly income limit for a household of one is \$2,266 and for a household of two is \$3,052.
