Updating Wage Grid Implementation Criteria Related To Red Circling

WHEREAS, in April 2023, the County Board approved a new wage grade to be effective October 1, 2023, and set criteria for implementation; and,

WHEREAS, due to factors including the spread between steps and each employee's current compensation, and under the rules governing implementation, 40 employees were identified as Red Circled; and,

WHEREAS, implementing this resolution will result in an annualized increased cost.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled this <u>26th</u> day of <u>October</u>, 2023 does hereby update the wage grid implementation criteria to provide a yearly lump sum payment to those employees identified as Red Circled equal to the difference between the amount added to their base wages under the Red Circling policy and the amount they would have received through the COLA as provided to other non-bargained employees had they not been Red Circled. This annual lump sum payment will continue until at which time the employee is no longer considered Red Circled based on current policies and procedures.
