Amending the 2023 Human Services Department Budget to Accept Funding from the Community Mental Health Services Block Grant Supplemental Funds

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) has provided additional funding opportunities to support individuals with mental health struggles impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic through the Community Mental Health Services Block Grant Supplemental funds; and,

WHEREAS, Rock County has received \$73,312 in additional funds to be added to the 2023 budget; and,

WHEREAS, Rock County will use the funding to support direct services in the community for people with mental illness; and,

WHEREAS, this funding is to be used between March 15, 2023 and March 14, 2024.
