Recognizing Captain Douglas A. Coulter

WHEREAS, Douglas A. Coulter began his employment with Rock County on June 13, 1990, as a Correctional Officer in the Rock County Sheriff’s Office working in the Correctional Services Division, was hired as a Deputy Sheriff on June 13, 1994, was promoted to Sergeant on December 18, 2010 and promoted to Captain on November 2, 2020; and,

WHEREAS, Captain Douglas Coulter has diligently served the citizens of Rock County as a dedicated and valued employee of Rock County over the past 32 years, and having worked under six Sheriffs over the course of his career: F. Joseph Black, Howard Erickson, Eric Runaas, Robert Spoden, Troy Knudson and Curtis Fell; and,

WHEREAS, Captain Coulter has served as a Field Training Officer, D.A.R.E Officer, Crime Prevention Deputy, Special Weapons and Tactics (SWAT) Team Member, Child Passenger Safety Technician, Motor Unit Supervisor, Instructor in Range, EVOC and Vehicle Contacts and TIME Agency Coordinator (TAC); and,

WHEREAS, Captain Coulter has received numerous letters of appreciation and commendations, including the Deputy of the Year award in 2000, Pistol Sharpshooter award in 2003 and Retired Sheriffs award in 2019. Captain Coulter has been assigned to many bureaus within the Sheriff’s Office, such as the Jail, Patrol, Training, Special Investigations Unit (SIU) and Court Services; and,

Whereas, Captain Douglas Coulter will retire from public service on May 5, 2023.
